1. A jamming station has been located in Baneasa near Bucharest since December 1954. The head of the station, and holding the rank of director general, is an East German radio specialist, Dr. Schmidt, from Frankfurt on the Oder. Transmission and amplifier installations have been under construction since December 1954. 25X1

2. [redacted] in December 1954, Dr. Schmidt stated that the jamming had little effect, and proposed drastic measures and complete jamming of foreign transmitters beaming programs in Rumania. He proposed jamming not only Rumanian programs of BBC, VOA, and RFE, but also the Rumanian broadcasts from Belgrade, Athens, Istanbul, Rome, Madrid and Paris. 25X1

[redacted] The propaganda section of the Soviet High Command, reported to be in Craiova, sent back an answer stating that the Soviet themselves were in a position to jam foreign broadcasts and did not need the help of Dr. Schmidt. 25X1
