Between 0800 and 1400 on 2 June 1955, 24 MiG-15s were counted at Parndorf airfield. Most of the aircraft were parked in the eastern section of the field. No changes on the MiG-15 types were observed. 1 There was 8/10 overcast at an altitude of about 1,500 meters, intermittent rain, westerly wind of about 20 km/h, good visibility, the Leitha Mts were hazy. No air activity was observed. MiG-15s with blue stripes on the upper third of their rudder assembly were seen similar to those previously observed at Wiener Neustadt airfield.

The AA gun emplacement, which was guarded by sentries, was equipped with six light AA guns of a new type. Fifteen trucks, 3 van-like trucks, and 5 tank trucks, were parked under the lean-to roof.

Personnel wearing fatigue uniforms performed maintenance work on parked motor vehicles. The fuel depot and two fuel tanks were guarded by sentries. Six tents were observed near the radar station equipped with "Kniferest" and "Fishnet" type sets.

The following aircraft and equipment were seen near the aircraft repair shop:

- 2 MiG-15s with dismantled tails resting on supports.
- 1 MiG-15 Both aircraft had no stripes. 2
- 6 grey jet engine crates
- 3 small grey crates measuring about 75 x 50 x 30 cm

One small shed or a van-like truck trailer with mast and wind sock was seen at the eastern end of the airfield.

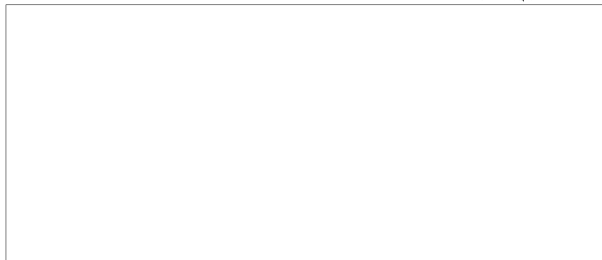
3. The former Agricultural School in Bruck on the Leitha River was guarded by sentries wearing black-bordered blue epaulets. Three officers wearing blue-bordered blue epaulets entered and left the building. No motor vehicles were observed.
