SOURCE EVALUATIONS ARE DELETED

1. During May 1955 the airfield was occupied by a total of 50 to 55 MiG-15-type aircraft. It could not be ascertained how many of these were U-MiG-15's. 25X1
2. The extent to which the personnel on the airfield has been increased is difficult to estimate, but there has definitely been a considerable increase in the number of air force personnel seen in the town of Neuruppin itself since April 1955.
3. The ammunition depot which probably belongs to the airfield is situated at MR 522 690. It is 30 m. distant from the airfield perimeter fence and lies on the north side of the path branching West from the Neuruppin - Rheinsberg road.
4. About 25 m. south of the ammunition depot at MR 522 690, there is a Token radar array. From the beginning to the middle of May, a heap of earth was dumped in the vicinity, but the reason for this is not yet apparent.
