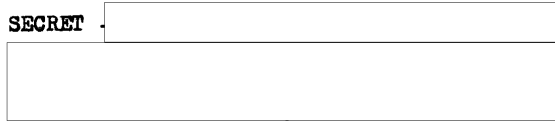



1. Comment. Incoming motor vehicles within the current Soviet motor vehicle replacement program. on 4 and 5 June are probably identical with the tank trucks which has been reported previously. The shipment of three-axle trucks on 4 and 6 June reported previously by another source.  25X1
2. Comment. Incoming shipments of raw materials consigned to the Eisenhatten-Kombinat-Ost in Fuerstenberg-Oder which is served by Ziltendorf as railroad station. 25X1
3. Comment. Shipments from the USSR within the framework of the grain import program. Some of the shipments will be dispatched on inland waterways. 25X1
4. Comment. The crude oil allegedly sent to Ruhleben, which was probably not the place of destination, may have been dispatched to Radensleben, the location of the Soviet fuel dump, or to Ruhland, the location of the Schwarzheide hydrogenation plant. If the shipment was dispatched to a GDR hydrogenation plant, it consisted of crude oil; if the shipment was, however, consigned to a Soviet fuel dump as they exist in Aken or Radensleben, the tank cars certainly contained gasoline. 25X1
