It appeared the supervision on the trips was to prevent contact by the seamen the local populace. Whenever seamen began to wander from the p, they were called back and their guides displayed considerable leasure. The woman continually counted the seamen, thereby nstrating that she was assigned to keep track of them. All actions, uding the attempted wanderings by the seamen, were reported to the ot.
