- Aircraft count (20 June 1955):  
28 IL 28's

- Flying activity:
  - By day:

(1) On week days there was considerable flying activity by IL 28's in the form of cross-country flights and formation flights. In the cross-country flights, the IL 28's were fitted with wing tanks and were absent from the airfield for over one and one half hours. Formation flying was carried out by 8-10 IL 28's.

- By night:

(1) On 17 June, at approximately 2100 hours, night flying with 4 IL 28's was observed, but only take-offs and landings could be seen. Normal airfield lighting was used.

- AA's

Ten guns were observed on the fringe of the wood northeast of the airfield. The guns were covered and dug in, and had an estimated caliber of approximately 70 mm.

- Ground Radio/Radar:

A radio truck was in position at the take-off end of the runway when flying was in progress.
