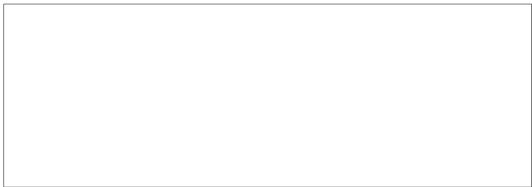

1. Within the area of the Joseph Stalin works at Labedy (Laband) (N 50-20, E 18-37) there is a tank shop. This shop is surrounded by a double fence and is guarded by armed patrols.
2. Tanks are assembled here; prefabricated steel forms are shipped into the plant. Engines are also shipped in from outside, presumably from Radom. No tank repair work is done; only new tanks of the T-34 type leave the plant. No old or dirty tanks have been seen in the area.
3. Tank assembly work is often interrupted. Workers' estimates of production vary between two and ten tanks per week. Finished tanks are tested in a field located behind the assembly shop.
