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2. Manufacture of phenol and talcum from coal tar falls below the Yugoslav requirements, but an additional plant to increase production is being installed at the Boris Kidric Works in Kidricevo. Yugoslavia hopes to have surplus quantities of coal-tar derivatives which will be available for export during 1956. 25X1

3. At present Yugoslavia has a surplus of up to 3,000 tons of coal-tar available for export, which is being offered for sale or barter to chemical firms. 25X1

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
