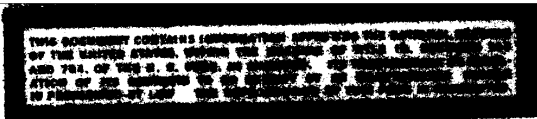

1. Comment. These were fuel shipments from the USSR. 25X1
2. Comment. Motor vehicles were the frame work of the motor vehicle exchange program previously reported. 10 September were ILLEGIB
3. Comment. These were export shipments of the GDR industry. ILLEGIB
4. Comment. The shipments involved uranium ore for the USSR.
5. Comment. Ammunition shipments to and from known ammunition depots.
6. Comment. Military goods, possibly weapons, aircraft, or vehicles, were retransferred to the USSR.

7. Comment. The type of lead was described in words written in Cyrillic letters. 25X1
