- 3. [Redacted] Comment. Incoming shipments of new motor vehicles and outgoing
shipments of obsolete vehicles within the framework of the exchange

- 4. [Redacted] Comment. The shipments dispatched from Moegelin and Rathenow
are possibly identical in spite of the different dates. These
shipments presumably transferred surplus 120-mm mortars to the
USSR. A shipment with 11 x 120-mm mortars, dispatched from Biesenthal

- 5. [Redacted] Comment. Outgoing shipments with military goods including
vehicles, weapons, equipment or aircraft to the USSR. Similar shipments,

- 7. [Redacted] Comment. Ration supply shipments.
