4. On 13 Cctober, no ground attack aircraft were observed at the airfield. About seven jet fighters were parked in the eastern hangar, in front of which two canvas-covered twin-engine jet fighters, presurably II-28s, were seen. About three To-2s were parked at the eastern portion of the field. About 2,CCC cots, including double-decked and triple-decked beds, were placed in the western hangar. A soldier stated, that these cots have been made available for the raneuvers. About 12C tank trucks were parked in the hangar, southwest of the western hangar. I engine test-stands at the field were in operation almost daily.

<u>Corment</u>. Approximately 6 Cotober, the ground attack regiment transferred for exercises of the Sighth Gds Army hold in Thuringia. It as assumed that the regiment will then be retransferred to its former post at Frandenburg-Briest. FiG-15s and II-22s observed at the field are used for training purposes by the air technical school. These 2,000 cots were reported by the same source on 4 Cotober 1955.

<u>Comment</u>. On 1 September, an instruction unit departed from Puilding No 16. The recruits renticeed, may be rembers of a new instruction course, lajor Polikov was chief of the departed unit.
