A. Summary of the Suggestion:

Suggester proposed that the following slogan in the form of a small poster might be suitable for distribution to offices as a security reminder:

Carefully

Intelligence
Target
Yourself

B. Evaluation of the Concerned Office:

Chief, Survey Branch, Office of Security on 26 November 1956 stated the following:

"It is the opinion of this Office that the idea embodied in Employee Suggestion No. 2651 is capable of development into an effective Security poster which could be used throughout Headquarters.

"This suggestion will be retained in the Security Poster Program file of the Security Office for implementation at an appropriate time.

"While it is not possible to evaluate this suggestion in terms of monetary savings, this office feels that such a slogan, or poster, would have a definite tangible value in the promotion of Physical Security and that it merits at least a commendation to the employee concerned."

C. Recommendation of the Executive Secretary:

1. Letter of appreciation at this time.
2. Reopen the case for further consideration in the event OS actually uses the idea proposed. [redacted] has agreed to advise SA Staff if idea is used.
