A. Summary of Suggestion

The driveway from the front of "Q" Building to Constitution Avenue crosses a sidewalk parallel to the avenue. My suggestion is that some effort be made--by instructing Agency drivers, by enhancing the visibility of the sign, by policing that intersection for a time, or whatever--to ensure that drivers learn to stop before crossing the sidewalk.

B. Summary of Evaluations

On 17 October 1957, the Agency Safety Officer recommended the suggestion not be adopted saying:

"Agency drivers are instructed on a semiannual basis by the Safety Officer as to the most glaring safety violations. The visibility of the sign, presently located in the middle of the drive, appears to be the best possible. Additional signs would only tend to confuse the drivers. The main CIA guard office is located in Que Building and guards are continually going and coming from this area. Any violations noted are reported immediately, and personnel warned. The guard office will be requested to make a special effort in stopping these violators. However, the entire lot is basically controlled by guards furnished by the Navy group. If the Agency were to add an additional guard post to police this area, the cost would be approximately \$7,000 per year and violations do not seem frequent enough to justify this expense."

C. Suggestion Awards Staff Note

On 19 November 1957 Committee member [REDACTED] recommended that the suggestion be put on the Agenda for discussion, saying:

"Action will be taken to implement the suggestion. The guard office will be requested to make a special effort in stopping these violations."

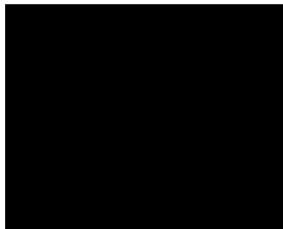

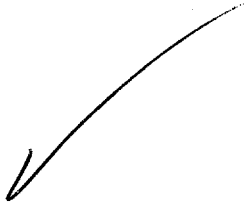
