Special security police guarded the entrances and strategic spots around the fences or walls. They had orders to shoot anyone who touched the fences or walls. There were several instances where drunks returning home at night, who accidentally leaned or fell against the fences, were shot without hesitation. Most of the war factories had tunnel entrances where railroad cars were loaded and unloaded so that persons not actually engaged in the loading operations would not know what was going out or coming in. Even in peace time the Soviets tried to hide the identity of shipments from important plants. Laborers were instructed to keep still about the tasks they performed, and consequently were afraid to talk.
