MEMORANDUM FOR THE FILES

About 4:15 p.m. Col. White called stating that no final decision had been made on permitting the extension of the audit in CIA. He stated that there had been several meetings with Mr. Dulles and that there were one or <sup>two</sup> fundamental problems which had to be resolved and there could be further discussions at the staff level on it. It was his understanding that Allen Dulles is going to see Mr. Campbell on these fundamental problems. Col. White was urged to do what he could to get this meeting as promptly as possible so that we could inform the House Committee on Armed Services whether or not a meeting of the minds had been reached between the GAO and CIA on the extension of the audit.
