MEMORANDUM FOR: Director of Central Intelligence

SUBJECT: Authentication of Travel Regulations

1. This memorandum suggests action on the part of the Director of Central Intelligence. Such action is requested in paragraph 6.



3. On 1 December 1950 the Director delegated to the Deputy Director (Support) authority to administer official travel and transportation generally throughout the Agency.

4. Your approval of the memorandum from the Deputy Director (Support), dated 9 June 1960, subject: "Processing Agency Regulatory Material," authorized him to discontinue extensive coordination of issuances of a routine nature or occasioned by changes required by law or by administrative action of other Federal agencies, including issuances on the subject of travel.

5. Consistent with these authorizations and to expedite further the issuance of regulations of a fundamentally administrative nature, I have requested the Office of General Counsel to prepare for your signature the attached authorization pertaining to travel regulations. The theory of this authorization is as follows:

As pointed out above, the Agency regulations on travel, in large part, are derived from

normal statutory or general regulatory provisions, so to this extent they can be issued by the Deputy Director (Support) without your specific approval.

Since the policies and standards limiting the use of confidential funds are now well-established, there appears to be no reason why the Deputy Director (Support) should not promulgate travel regulations relating to such expenditures consistent with the policies and standards previously established by you. Under the attached authorization, changes in established policies or standards relating to such expenditures would continue to require your approval.

6. Therefore, I recommend signature of the attached authorization for the Deputy Director (Support) to issue general travel regulations, including those aspects relating to confidential funds, within the foregoing limitations.
