25X1A9a [redacted] explained to [redacted] the meeting of last week which consisted of Alan Evans, HSC, the head of Far East section of OIR and a representative from Biographic Intelligence, State Department. Evans said at that time that he thought that research performed by his shop could be credited against NIS budget and time on the subject of Indonesia. [redacted] is inclined to disagree with Mr. Evans' idea as to how to approach this problem. The result will be a meeting after the holidays of [redacted] Evans, [redacted] and a representative from DDP (NEA Division). 25X1A9a
