SUBJECT : Handling of Sensitive Material

Same Subject

This Directorate can identify no categories of materials which, by their subject matter or classification, routinely bypass the Executive Registry. A few cases in which DDI papers bypass the Executive Registry are almost exclusively concerned with sensitive policy issues. In these cases, the restrictions on circulation of such papers are at the direction of the DCI, Dr. Kissinger, or other high officials of the NSC Staff. We obviously cannot identify these papers in advance. We equally have no choice but to respect restrictions placed on these papers.
