1. On 28 December we were asked for our advice as to the future handling of Cubans in Miami. There will be a meeting called in the White Mouse on 31 December to discuss this, and prior to that time could you make your views known to the DDCI. 2. For your general guidance, there is some indication that higher authority wishes to establish a focal point for dealing with the Cubans in Miami and this may well be placed under the general guidance of the Department of State. This could include the location of a senter foreign service officer probably with the rank of ambassador to deal with the Cubans in Miami.
