SUBJECT : Painting, Headquarters Building

REFERENCE:

1. I am sure Gates Lloyd has told you that he, along with representatives of the Fine Arts Commission, has been engaged in discussions with the General Services Administration regarding the development of a master color scheme for the headquarters building. As this project is a major undertaking, we anticipate it will take approximately one month for Mr. Yasko of Public Building Services to present a general outline of a color pattern for the building. Upon completion, Mr. Yasko's proposals will be reviewed by the Fine Arts Commission along with representatives of your office. Depending upon the outcome of this review, it may still require more time before the execution of the new colors can be initiated.

2. In view of the foregoing, it would be appreciated if you would request that all painting in headquarters building be stopped, except for emergency requirements, until the action set forth in paragraph 1 is concluded.
