MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN, UNITED STATES INTELLIGENCE BOARD

SUBJECT: Request for SNIE on Brazil

1. In light of Brazil's continuing governmental crisis and serious economic deterioration, the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff has requested that the United States Intelligence Board develop, as a matter of priority, a SNIE on the situation and prospects for Brazil.

2. This SNIE should analyze the political, military, economic and subversive situation; assess trends; and estimate future prospects. In the development of the estimate, popular attitudes and other factors of instability susceptible to exploitation should be examined and critical phases (or actions) in likely Communist/Leftist programs to seize power should be identified. A section on Brazil's probable future foreign relations would also be helpful to the Chairman, JCS.
