Dear Admiral Raborn:

At the recent session of the Eighteen Nation Disarmament Conference, much of the discussion centered on comprehensive and threshold test bans. This discussion is currently continuing at the United Nations General Assembly. Recognizing the importance of nonmilitary factors in determining the merits of a test ban, the Joint Chiefs of Staff would greatly appreciate your views on certain aspects of comprehensive and threshold test bans.
