This memorandum will serve to reaffirm the policy stated in Agency regulation establishing a special pay schedule for specially qualified scientific and technical personnel with a pay range extended from the base of GS-16 through GS-18. Effective as of the date of the enactment of the Government Employees Salary Reform Act of 1964, the nine pay levels provided in the Agency's Scientific Pay Schedule shall be equated with the pay levels for GS-16 through GS-18 as indicated below:

## General Schedule Scientific Pay Schedule 08-16, Steps 1 through 4 Levels (a) through (d) Levels (e) through (h) GS-17, Steps 1 through 4 Level (1)

2. Adjustment of the pay rates of the Agency's Scientific Pay Schedule to correspond to revision of the general compensation schedules, provisions for initial adjustment of salaries to such revised schedules, and other changes in the Classification Act will be given effect in the future by the Central Intelligence Agency whenever the law is amended. The effective date of such revisions and changes will be in accordance with the provisions of law making such changes.
