

Dear Mr. Hodges:

The Department of State has proposed transfer to the Central Intelligence Agency on 1 July 1961 of responsibility for production and maintenance of basic intelligence on foreign countries in the sociological, political, and economic portions of the National Intelligence Survey which have heretofore been performed by the Department of State.

In accepting this responsibility I want to ensure the maximum effective utilisation of the established civilian agencies. Specifically, I suggest for your consideration the assignment to the Department of Commerce of the production and maintenance for those portions of the National Intelligence Survey which relate to your departmental responsibilities and facilities. These portions are: Section 41 (Population), Section 54 (Manufacturing and Construction), and Section 65 (Trade and Finance).

I have designated Assistant Director for Basic Intelligence, to represent me in discussion of the problem with such representatives as you may wish to meet with him.

NIS Costs in Commerce

Funding arrangements have been concluded with the following components of Department of Commerce to prepare designated NIS sections, with build-up of staffs occurring during FY 1962.

1) Section 41 (Population) - Bureau of Census

- 5 countries Cost FY 62 = Cost FY 63 = - 8 countries

2) Section 64 (Manufacturing and Construction) - Business and Defense Services Administration

- 4 countries Cost FY 62 = Cost FY 63 = - 8 countries

3) Section 65 (Trade and Finance) - Bureau of Foreign Commerce

- 5 countries Cost FY 62 = - 8 countries Cost FY 63

I have found that few anticipate the difficulty of turning out first-class NIS sections, so that costs will probably increase somewhat with more experience in this field. Even so, this level of funding is below average costs of similar staffs in Agriculture and Interior and considerably less than State's.
