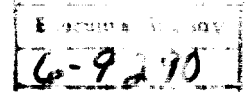

In the event more time is needed to complete the questionnaire, an interim reply to the ICIS, noting that fact would be appreciated. It is requested that the information furnished be sufficiently detailed to enable the ICIS to accurately assess the degree to which Executive Order 10501 is being implemented by your Agency.

You will note that the information requested is to cover the period from December 15, 1953 (the effective date of Executive Order 10501), through March 31, 1955. Thereafter, the ICIS will request similar reports on a semiannual basis.
