Dear Miss Feldman:

Governor Sherman Adams has sent me your letter, and his reply, concerning the possibility of awarding the National Security Medal to Mr. Joseph C. Harsch for his articles in the Christian Science Monitor in support of President Eisenhower's remarks concerning the national budget.

The National Security Medal was established by Executive Order 10431 of 19 January 1953. Paragraph 1 of the "Regulations Governing the Award of the National Security Medal" reads as follows:

1. The National Security Medal may be awarded to any person without regard to nationality, including a member of the Armed Forces of the United States, who, on or after 26 July 1947, has made an outstanding contribution to the National intelligence effort. This contribution may consist of either exceptionally meritorious service performed in a position of high responsibility or of an act of valor requiring personal courage of a high degree and complete disregard of personal safety.

I am sure, therefore, you will agree with me that Mr. Harsch's activities would not come within the purview of the Executive Order, namely, "an outstanding contribution to the National Intelligence effort."
