MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

Morning Meeting of 30 June 1965

25X1 During the current intelligence briefing the Director was given a working aid on Communist [redacted]

25X1 DDP noted that McGeorge Bundy would undertake to present the Agency's views on Cuba in bringing this issue to the attention of the President and other top officials. DDP also noted a request for more US [redacted] effo 25X1 in [redacted]

25X1 DDS&T noted the acceptance of the third operational OXCART and then excused himself to attend the Kinzel Board.

Bross noted the agenda would be forthcoming on the PFIAB meeting on 9 July. He also suggested that NRO had boiled itself down to one unresolved issue.

Houston noted a firm appointment for the Director with Representative Rivers at 8:00 a. m. on 1 July. He noted the Senate Foreign Relations Committee would open hearings on the Dominican Republic on 12 July. There was a discussion of the Agency's support to the Department of State. The DDCI asked that we monitor the security of the transcript and any releases with great care.

Earman reported a recent flurry of personal appeals to the Inspector General.

25X1 DDS alerted the meeting to a possible flap involving communications from [redacted]. He reported the letting of a contract for the parking lot and a heliport. He noted plans to [redacted] 25X1 He noted the new CT (ex-JOT) class would be starting soon. He noted complimentary remarks about our recruiters by two US universities.

25X1 [redacted] was advised that the Director felt that further sessions with NSA would be useful and requested advice.

Kent noted statements by Chet Cooper about security on US actions in Vietnam.

Cline delivered comments on a paper by the Secretary of Defense and he noticed the status of the China paper for possible USIB consideration.

Kirkpatrick noted that Ambassador Koren would be in the Agency on 2 July.

DDCI noted there would be a meeting with DIA regarding Laos. DDCI noted an appointment for the DCI and DDCI with the Secretary of State at 3:00 p.m. on 2 July.

DCI asked the staff to be alert to any suggestions as to how intelligence might support the air strikes against North Vietnam.

DCI requested for his personal information a report on Bunker's mission to the Dominican Republic.

DCI discussed mandantory fitness reports, a project which is being staffed out.
