The Acting DDI noted the presence of the [REDACTED] to discuss Soviet ground forces. He also noted the proposed text for Department of State announcement on the forthcoming Chinese test.

DCI wants to see the post-strike photographs of the attacks on the Dong Hoi barracks area.

DCI was advised that Ray Cline is being kept informed by a daily briefing cable.

DCI asked DDP for information about a Latin American labor resolution concerning a boycott of Cuba.

DCI requested DDCI to consider the resumption of TACKLE flights, the removal of the restriction on the use of SAC U-2's over China, and the use of ECM gear on U-2's over Cuba.

DCI directed that there be two operational U-2's [redacted] and that NPIC scan planned flight routes. 25X1
