Morning Meeting of 3 September 1965

Warner reported that he had briefed Zablocki yesterday on the [redacted]. He believes that the situation is in hand. In this connection, the DCI noted a call he had received from McGeorge Bundy this morning in which the latter asked that a check be made within the Agency to ascertain



There was a briefing on the Congo (Brazzaville) by [redacted]

Cline tabled a paper on desertions in SVN. The DCI will take copies of this to his meeting with the JCS this afternoon. Cline noted that the [redacted] were going to discuss a memorandum today which proposed negotiations to end the confrontation with [redacted]. He tabled two reports from ORR, one on seaborne infiltration into SVN, and the other on shipping to Cuba. The DCI will also take these memoranda to his JCS meeting.

R. Jack Smith noted that the most serious development which could occur as a result of the current fighting in Kashmir would be the eruption of communal riots in India and Pakistan. (See Action Item 3) He noted the [redacted]. He noted a Weekly article on Soviet and Chinese aid to NVN. DCI will take these to his JCS meeting this afternoon.

Abbot Smith reported that he would be sending to the DCI today a background paper on Kashmir.

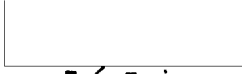
Peer deSilva noted that the [redacted] team will be working with the Marines at [redacted] over the weekend. In response to a question from the DCI, he reported that the results of the tests on the [redacted] would be available in about a week. (See Action Item 4) The DCI urged that a

Warner reported on his conversation with Stennis regarding Young of Ohio. The DCI complimented Legislative Counsel on its work on the Hill.

Bross reported that Wheelon will be briefing Vance next week on defensive systems for the U-2.

Wheelon reported on his conversation yesterday with [redacted] and [redacted] said that a letter would be prepared for the DCI's signature thanking [redacted] for his work with the Agency. He suggested that Ledford meet with the DCI sometime soon to discuss the question of procurement of more U-2's. He reported on a [redacted] which confirmed [redacted] He initiated a discussion of the proposed outgoing cable to [redacted] concerning U-2 coverage of the Sino-Indian border from [redacted] and noted difficulties that would be encountered if such coverage was attempted from [redacted]. The DCI expressed his desire to move cautiously on this item.

2. DCI requested that India/Pakistan be covered in a morning briefing soon. (DDI)

3. DCI requested that he be given figures on the ethnic breakdowns in India and Pakistan. (DDI ... [redacted] of OCI is ready to respond at any time. Action - EA/DCI)

4. The DCI requested that he be furnished a sample [redacted] for his meeting with the JCS today. (SAVA)

5. The DCI requested that deSilva review the FE presentation which he will be giving to the JCS today. (SAVA)

6. The DCI will call Clark Clifford and offer a briefing on the [redacted] (EA/DCI)
