General Carroll prefers that the present arrangements be continued. The Director asked DD/I to discuss the proposal again with General Carter.

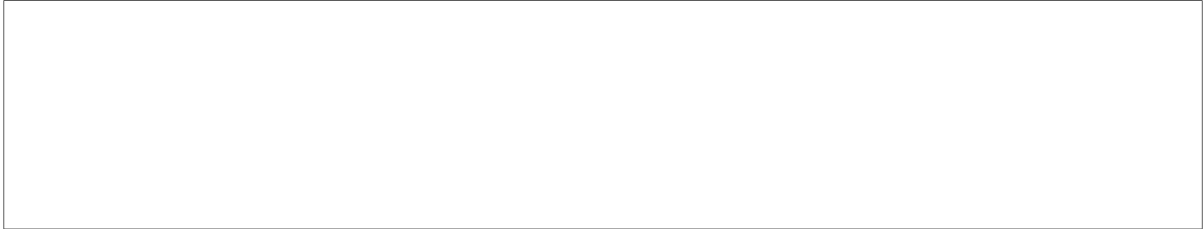
