The Director stated that since Budget had asked for our views on this matter we should counter their proposal by suggesting that Mr. Schaub continue his liaison duties with CIA in addition to his new duties with Defense, assisted by Mr. Macy. Mr. Dulles undertook to pass this counterproposal along to Mr. Macy when he sees him at 10:30 a.m. today.

Noted that (1) we were very well covered on the Bolivian Revolution; (2) this matter had been discussed with Eddie Miller of State some two months ago and he had made certain comments in connection therewith. The DCI stated that we should always ask for such comments in writing. Mr. Wisner noted that there was a memorandum of conversation on the above discussion with Mr. Miller. In connection with the Revolution, Mr. Wisner also noted that it appears that the Revolutionaries have won out and that they were anti-U.S. and pro-Argentine.
