1. I have talked with [redacted] by telephone and subject to your convenience he will come down here to spend Friday afternoon, April 4th with us arriving at 2:30 PM.

2. He will have our mutual friend available, unless we notify him to the contrary, although I made it clear that we wish to have a considerable time with him alone.

3. I told [redacted] that he could count upon 650 and that we would consider slightly increasing this if clearly justified. I said, however, that we would much prefer to hold out, say 50 to meet particularly meritorious projects that could not be financed out of the annual allotment. I return your draft letter which it is unnecessary now to send, but which you might use for a basis for our conversation with [redacted]
