Dear Senator Rastland:

Thank you for your letter of 34 May requesting information concerning past cases of Soviet explorage in the United States, its territories and possessions, for publication by the Internal Security Subcommittee for the information of the Senate of the United States.

By a provise contained in the National Security Act of 1947, as anended, the Cantral Intelligence Agency is precluded from all police, subposed, and internal security activities. As a consequence of the above preclusion, we do not gather the type of information you desire. We collect this kind of information only from various foreign countries and sources abroad, which activity is within the scope of our responsibilities under the law.
