Now I wish to add the support of my 43 years as a critic of theatre and dance to the words of John Martin (enclosed herewith), regarding ANTA's choice of the American Ballet Theatre to go to Russia on our "Special Program for Cultural Presentations."

It may well be that recent events will cause the cancellation of all such projects to Russia; if not, surely it is a most unwise project to send this -- or any - ballet group to the Soviet Union. I hope your organization will make this clear to the appropriate bodies.
