1. This memorandum transmits a letter for the signature of the Director of Central Intelligence nominating [ ] for the Arthur S. Flemming Awards Program.

2. The Junior Chamber of Commerce of Washington, D.C. sponsors annually the Arthur S. Flemming Awards Program honoring young men in the Federal Government. Mr. Robert D. Wallick is Chairman of the Arthur S. Flemming Awards Commission. A brochure describing this awards program is attached. This program is undertaken by the Junior Chamber of Commerce in order to strengthen the public service by bringing national recognition to young men who have performed outstanding and meritorious work for the Federal Government. Awards are granted each year to ten Federal employees - five to young men in scientific or technical fields, and five to young men in administrative or executive fields.

3. The Agency has not previously nominated anyone for the Arthur S. Flemming Awards. This year, however, the Deputy Director (Intelligence) has named [ ] as a qualified candidate for this award. The Career Council has reviewed this nomination and recommends that you nominate [ ] for an Arthur S. Flemming Award.
