

The IAI is a professional organization of over 375 members who meet periodically in the NSA auditorium to hear a recognized authority speak on a topic pertaining to international relations, science, economics or military affairs. Some of the more prominent speakers to address the Institute include Dr. Edward Teller, General Vernon Walters, Ambassador Averell Harriman, Dr. William Whitson and, most recently, Ambassador J. Rives Childs.

The Institute usually meets from 0930 to 1100 hours, but this can be changed to any time during the working day to meet your schedule. Normally, we allot 30 to 45 minutes for the formal address which leaves time (about 30 minutes) for an informal question and answer session with the audience. Following your presentation, we would hope that you would allow the Institute to host a luncheon in your honor from 1115 to 1245.
