- 1. On 18 July 1962 the United States Intelligence Board approved the attached "Policy Statement Concerning Counterintelligence and Security Responsibilities." Although a considerable portion of this statement concerns installations and personnel overseas, the statement itself is so important and fundamental to all security practices that I believe it should be required reading on the part of all supervisors in the Agency from the branch level up.
