At the 29 October meeting of the Special Subcommittee chaired by Mr. Walter Rostow, it was noted that there is now a danger that recent events will lead many groups in Latin America to relax efforts toward social and economic reform. It was stated that a letter is being prepared for the President to send te Chiefs of State throughout Latin America to re-emphasize the importance of the Alliance.
- 2. The DD/P will insure that all field stations in the area give appropriate support to the mission chiefs in this effect.
- 3. The Office of the Director will be kept informed of significant action taken.
