SUBJECT : Response to NSAM 306. Subject: Language Training for U. S. Government Dependents
REFERENCE:

1. NSAM 306 directs that CIA, along with other U. S. Government agencies, develop specific details for training the dependents of Agency personnel stationed overseas. It further directs that CIA propose necessary legislative authority and appropriations through normal channels to support such training. The Director of Training, in consultation with the concerned Agency components, will be responsible for preparing a reply addressed to Mr. Bundy indicating that the Agency is complying with NSAM 306 in a constructive manner.

2. In preparing this reply you should consult the Clandestine Services to determine what policies and practices they now follow in regard to language instruction for dependents abroad.

3. Since NSAM 306 is addressed to most Government agencies operating overseas, we should also explore the practicality of having our



4. When you have determined what additional training is necessary to comply with NSAM 306, you should then consult with BPAM to see that adequate funds are available. It will also be necessary for the Office of the General Counsel to determine if the Agency has adequate authority to expend funds for this type of training.
