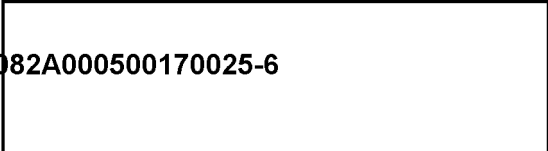
1. Training

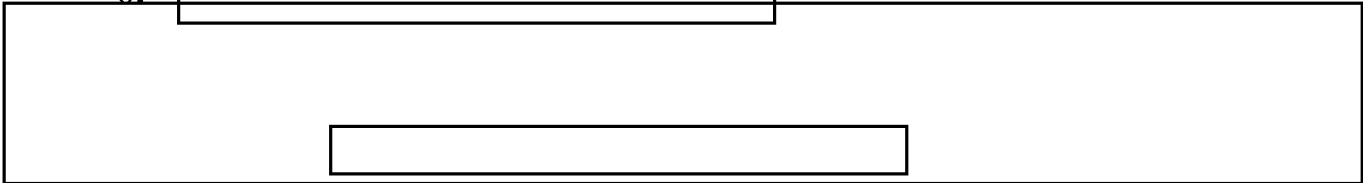

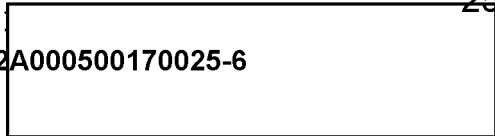

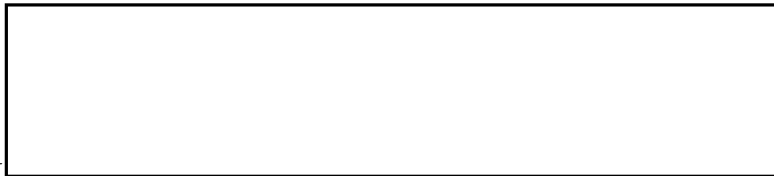
