The Critical Collection Problems Committee of USIB is by nature a permanent study group responsive to requests submitted to it by the DCI. The CCPC meets at the call of the Chairman. It is composed of representatives of State, DIA, CIA, NSA, Treasury, AEC, FBI, Army, Navy and Air Force. The Chairman is a member of the D/DCI/IC Staff.

The Committee also maintains an Inventory of U.S. Intelligence Facilities Overseas.

The wide range of CCPC activities over the past two years is indicated by the following list of studies:
