Morning Meeting of 15 August 1968

DD/I advised that the Warnke request concerning our ability to monitor such developments as MIRV will be handled by DD/S&T.

DD/I initiated a discussion concerning the handling of Walt Rostow's request concerning contingency intelligence initiatives in the event of a cease-fire in Vietnam. It was agreed that DDCI, DD/I, and Bross would resolve the matter later today.

Lehman drew attention to the annex in last evening's Vietnam Situation Report which outlines in detail the current enemy order of battle.
