As Mr. Carver explained in his telephone conversation with you on 11 May, we have modified the format and coloring of the graphs and tables in an effort to make them easier to read and interpret at a glance. On the summary graphs, the '68 data is subordinated into the background, the '69 data shown with a line, and the 1970, or current, data highlighted by summary bars.
