Many thanks for your letter of 3 February 1958 concerning your contact with a young man who says he has developed a machine which will translate Russian into English or any other language in just a few seconds.

We have had intensive interest in the development of a machine capability for translation since 1952, and since 1956 have supported such development financially through the National Science Foundation. Mechanical translation of languages has progressed steadily and by this autumn actual demonstrations will be possible translating Russian scientific literature into English by machine.

I won't burden you here with further details, but if you are interested in learning more about the state of the art of machine translation, I should be happy to have my senior staff officers responsible for the subject call on you.

We have been in touch with Mr. Small of Senator Kuchel's office in line with your suggestion.
