## USIB Agreed Changes to the US Position Paper for

## Standing Group Intelligence Estimate for NATO Planning

## 1959 through 1965

In Part 1, Section 4, paragraph 24, page 46, insert the following new sentence, after the first sentence:

"They are making a gigantic effort to bring about conditions under which general war could occur without the USSR's receiving unacceptable damage, and it is not inconceivable that at some time during the period of this estimate they may conclude -- rightly or wrongly--that they have attained such a position of decisive military superiority."

In Part I, Section 4, paragraph 24, page 46, change the sentence which follows the parenthetical statement to read:

> "Moreover, they appear to be confident that the final victory of communism which they are determined to achieve is inevitable, and to be accomplished through political and economic forms of struggle and through types of military action which they consider as posing no great risks to thempelves."

In Part I, Section 5, paragraph 4a, page 51, change the phrase "and the NATO shield forces in particular" to read "including the NATO shield forces."
