

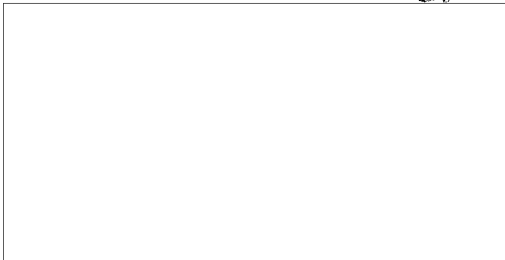

Mr. Dulles received the copy of your letter of 28 March just prior to leaving Washington for ten days' absence. He asked that I reply for him and state that he would be delighted to see [redacted] at any time, but that unfortunately he would not be in Washington during the week of 4 April. He arranged, however, for Lieutenant General C. P. Cabell, the Deputy Director, and the Acting Director in Mr. Dulles' absence, to see [redacted] should he call.

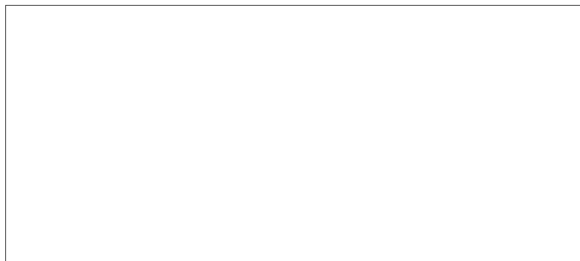
