1. Following the visit of the Director to Omaha where he was briefed by General LeMay, I suggested to General Walsh, Director of Intelligence of SAC, that he review the Strategic Air Command Intelligence requirements with a view to insuring that the requirements are current.

2. An advance copy of SAC's up-to-date list has been received. The original of these requirements has been transmitted by Strategic Air Command to Director of Intelligence, USAF. Until these requirements are passed on to us from Headquarters USAF, with such amendments as Air Force may make, the attached list represents the best presently available list of SAC Intelligence requirements. However, until the list is passed on to us from Air Force Headquarters, it is advance information and is not entirely definitive.

3. There are three principal target areas in which SAC is most vitally interested. They are:

James Walsh as the liaison officer with us, and either Gen. Walsh or one of his assistants can be made available for further discussion if you feel this would be productive. In general, however, I feel that the requirements are self-explanatory.

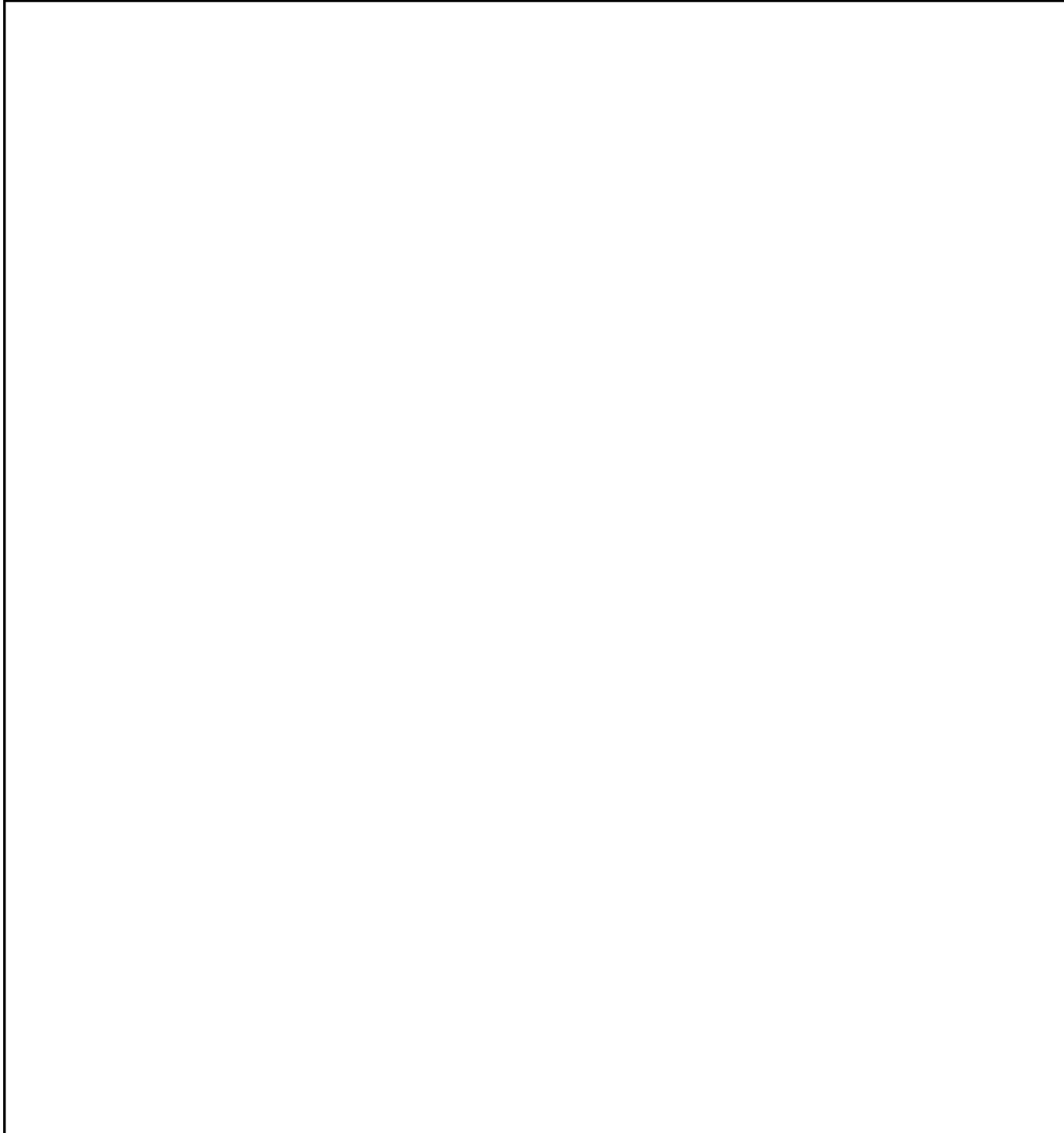
