MEMORANDUM FOR THE DIRECTOR


SUBJECT: Special Procedures Operations

1. Your attention is invited to the attached memorandum from the Chief, Special Procedures Group.
2. I concur in his recommendations.
3. However, in view of NSC 10/2, present personnel are handicapped in implementing their planned operations.
4. I feel that you should have this ammunition available for the scheduled NSC meeting this date.
5. It is obvious that although Mr. Lovett has indicated verbally his approval of the other project, the present Chief of Special Procedures Group and the undersigned cannot make definite guarantees and commitments to the Navy and Air Forces regarding control of this operation when the possibility exists that a new Chief of Special Procedures (Special Projects, NSC 10/2) will shortly take over control of such operations.

## The Hungarian Government Reacts to Rebuff by UN

BUDAPEST. — The Hungarian Telegraph Agency reports that the Hungarian government issued the following statement in connection with the decision of the United Nations Security council, barring Hungary's admission into the United Nations:

"The Hungarian government notes with deep regret and shock the decision of the United Nations Security council barring Hungary as a member of the United Nations.

The Hungarian Government is perplexed by the decision. At the same time, it takes cognizance with satisfaction of the decision that the governments of the Soviet Union, France, Poland, Syria and Colombia, supporters of the peace, greeted with joy and enthusiasm the decision of the United Nations, believing that an effective method of preventing international disputes has thus been established. Hungary anxiously waited for the conclusion of the peace treaty, and later for its ratification, desiring to become a member of the peacekeeping peoples at the earliest opportunity.

On the basis of the decision of the transformation and its self-sacrificing work of reconstruction, the Hungarian people consider itself rightly entitled to such membership. But now, having been deprived of its international right, it feels that, it is certain members of the Security Council who have rejected the Charter of the United Nations farscossas and untrue and rejects it categorically.

The institutions and social life of the Hungarian people underwent profound democratic transformations since the liberation. Hundreds of thousands of Hungarian peasants have been liberated from the oppression of the landlords, mainly by that very government which certain members of the Security Council accuse of representing the will of the people.

The Hungarian government considers the accusation, voiced in the Security Council, that it would be unable to fulfill its obligations under the charter of the United Nations farscossas and untrue and rejects it categorically.

The institutions and social life of the Hungarian people underwent profound democratic transformations since the liberation. Hundreds of thousands of Hungarian peasants have been liberated from the oppression of the landlords, mainly by that very government which certain members of the Security Council accuse of representing the will of the people.

Emphasizing its determination, that under no condition not even for membership in the United Nations, will it accept interference in the internal affairs and institutions of the country, the Hungarian Government reiterates at this time the fact that in Hungary civil and political liberty prevails, the fundamental human rights are honored and all citizens are entitled to freely express their opinion in words or in writing.

Millions of peasants and workers today feel free and endowed with full possession of their rights, while between the two wars they lived deprived of their human, civil and economic rights.
