- (b) The hospital received all supplies of medicine from RZESZOW, to which centre it was subordinate. There was no blood donors' bank at the hospital, and blood was also received from RZESZOW, in fluid form.

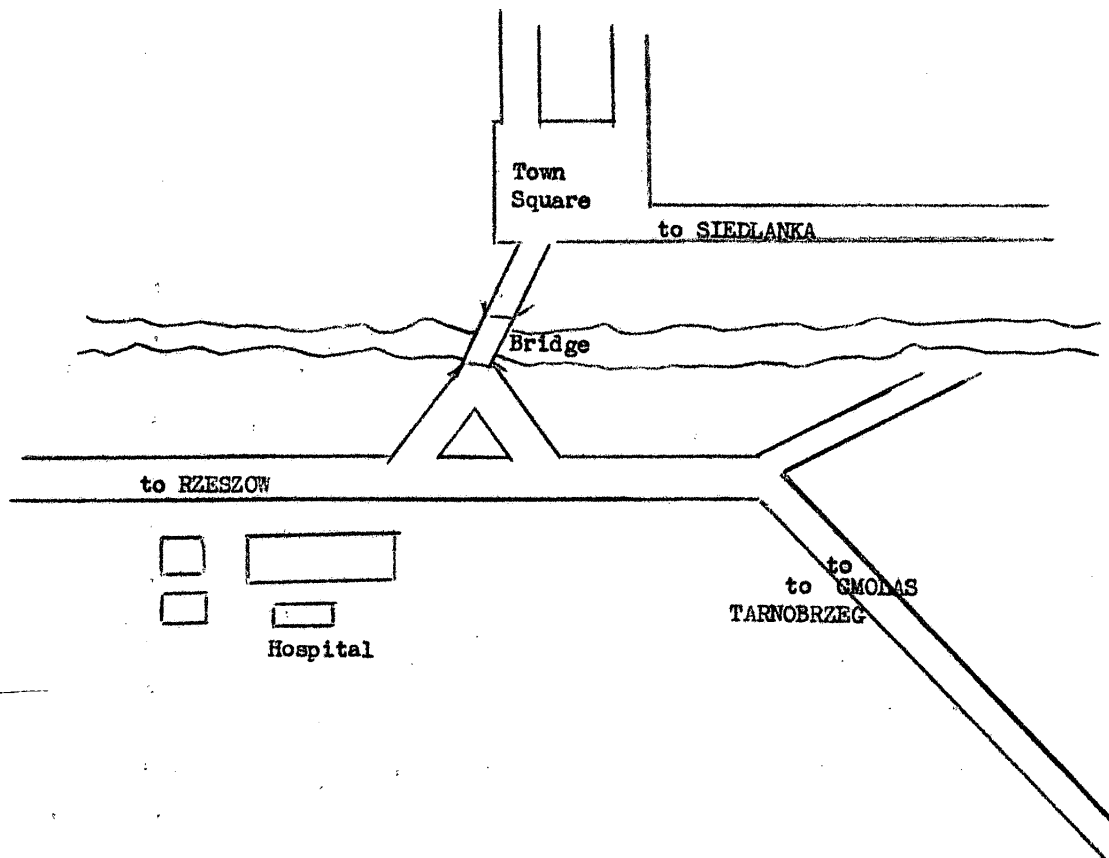
- (o) The penicillin used at the hospital was mainly of Polish manufacture, delivered in units of 300,000 and 600,000. Very little use was made of penicillin in form of pills or lozenges as both doctors and patients were sceptical about its effectiveness. There was a tendency to abuse penicillin, as there was always plenty of it. There was no Russian penicillin at the hospital

Polish streptomycin produced in laboratory quantities.
Auramycin and terramycin is freely available in Poland, but only at dispensaries dealing in imported medicines.
