- 1. At 1930 hrs on 4 Jan 58, a Soviet rail transport of 28 loaded 2-axled rail tankers passed through SPERENBERG travelling in the direction of ZOSSEN. The transport had come from FALKENBERG via JUETERBOG.
- 2. At 1900 hrs on 8 Jar 58, a Soviet rail transport consisting of 21 loaded 2-axled rail tankers passed through SPERENBERG travelling in the direction of ZOSSEN. The transport had come from FALKENBERG via JUETERBOG.
- 3. At 1400 hrs on 9 Jan 58, 4 x 6-exled flats, each loaded with a T54 tank, passed through SPERENBERG attached to a normal goods train travelling from KÖNIGSWUSTERHAUSEN to JUETERBOG. There were 3 Soviet troops with the transport. 50X1
